



CRFAIR Job Postings | Work Experience Opportunities Grants from the BC Ministry of Social Development and Social Innovation.

CRFAIR is a not-for-profit community based organization that acts as a coordinating backbone to a network of food, farm and health organizations (The Good Food Network) working to promote healthy and sustainable food systems in the Capital Region. We work hand in hand with key partner Victoria Community Food Hub Society (VCFHS) in effort to ensure that food systems provide healthy food to the most vulnerable people in our community and to increase their resources, food skills and social connections for a healthier future. We have 1 work experience placements available: these paid positions are funded with Work Experience Opportunities Grants from the BC Ministry of Social Development and Social Innovation.

Communications Assistant: This position will provide communications support for [South Island FarmHub](#), to enhance the customer experience, reach new audiences, and support fundraising. This position will include creating outreach materials and storytelling through social media content and emails, taking quality photos of produce and food boxes, updating and maintaining the website. Familiarity with Instagram, Facebook, Mailchimp and Wix are an asset.

- Start date: **as soon as possible**
- Pay (by stipend): \$20/hr
- 2 options for position duration:
 - Option 1: 15 hours per week for 12 weeks
 - Option 2: 7.5 hours per week for up to 16 weeks
- Position must end by March 31, 2022

To be considered for a position, due to the nature of the grants, applicants must be:

- an individual *qualified* to receive BC income or disability assistance, **or**
- *qualified* to receive assistance from a Treaty First Nation that is funded through the Federal Department of CrownIndigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada; **or**
- *qualified* to receive assistance from a First Nation Administering Authority that administers an Income Assistance Program on behalf of Indigenous Services Canada.

Note: applicants do not need to be actively in receipt of income or disability assistance payments from the BC Ministry of Social Development and Social Innovation (see [BC social supports eligibility](#)) or the Government of Canada.

For applicants who are receiving income assistance, the stipend associated with this position is exempt from BC income eligibility calculations and will not affect the eligibility of individuals participating. Individuals will need to declare the stipend to the ministry for tracking purposes.



How to Apply:

Please send a letter of interest and/or resume to hr@crfair.ca with subject line “WEOG Application - Communications.” Please indicate in your email whether you are interested in working 15 hours/week or 7.5 hours/week, and feel free to include in your email any questions you have about accessibility needs.

We will reply to your application with a Participant Form that must be completed to determine program eligibility. After we receive notice of eligibility from the Ministry, we will connect with you about the placement. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis as positions are filled.

CRFAIR and VCFHS are equal opportunity employers and encourage applications from individuals from diverse communities, backgrounds, abilities and experiences.
